On 15 of October the people of Poland are invited to participate in the general parliamentary election to elect the Sejm and the Senate. In the eyes of many, this time around the election is decisive as it will either cement the existing ruling coalition led by PiS or importantly reverse the country's political direction under the guidance of the present opposition. The outcome of the Polish election is, however, going to be important not only for Poland and its people, but it will inevitably reverberate all around the EU. For many years now, Poland has been, along Hungary, heavily criticized as a member state which has engaged in violations of the basic precepts of the rule of law and democracy. The outcome of the election therefore might also determine the quality of the overall standards of constitutional democracy in the EU for the years to come.

Against this backdrop, this European Academic Forum will discuss the following issues: What is at the heart of the political dispute in Poland?; How bad is the rule of law and democracy crisis in Poland?; What does this election result hold for Poland's and EU's future?
