Among the many challenges posed by such transformations is the issue of state succession. **How can the legal and legitimate closure of an old statehood chapter pave the way for a successful and efficient beginning of a new one?** This question will be central to the upcoming European Academic Forum, inspired by the recently published book *The Succession of States in International Law: The Case of Break-up and Succession after Yugoslavia* by Ana Polak Petrič and Grega Pajnkihar.
