ERASMUS PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH

New University Erasmus courses consists of lectures, seminars, tutorials, independent study, examinations, and other assessment activities essential for successful course completion.

As a small and private higher education institution, New University provides Erasmus+ and other exchange students with a highly personalized and distinctive learning experience. Our pedagogical approach emphasizes direct knowledge transfer through close interaction between students and faculty, blending academic expertise with innovative, practice-oriented teaching and research.

Most lectures take the form of individual consultations or in small groups (up to five students), allowing for in-depth discussions on course topics. These consultations are primarily conducted in person, fostering valuable face-to-face engagement, spontaneous discussions, and meaningful interpersonal connections. This approach not only enhances academic learning but also strengthens collaboration and a sense of belonging within the New University community.

For larger groups of incoming students, courses are conducted in Erasmus+ classes or, occasionally, with local students. Instruction is primarily in English, but those with sufficient Slovenian proficiency may join Slovenian students in curricular or extracurricular activities.

By integrating diverse pedagogical approaches, our academic staff fosters engaging and impactful learning experiences that enhance students' knowledge and critical awareness.

At New University, faculty members employ various teaching methods to facilitate knowledge transfer and stimulate meaningful discussions, including:

- **Topic-Based Discussions:** Exploring legal, social, economic, and cultural dimensions of key topics through open debate.
- **Problem-Based Learning:** Presenting real-world scenarios that require critical thinking, collaboration, and problem-solving.
- **Inquiry-Based Learning:** Encouraging students to ask questions, investigate topics, and develop understanding through exploration.
- **Collaborative Learning:** Promoting teamwork and peer-to-peer learning through group activities and discussions.
- **Socratic Method:** Engaging students with thought-provoking questions that challenge assumptions and deepen critical thinking.
- **Culturally Responsive Teaching:** Integrating diverse perspectives and cultural contexts to create an inclusive and relevant learning environment.

These methods ensure a dynamic and student-centered educational experience, equipping learners with the skills and perspectives necessary for academic and professional success. Special attention is also given to integrating AI and digitalization into the study environment.

ERASMUS DIGITAL APPROACH

New University is committed to digitalization in education, providing a modern, flexible, and accessible learning environment.

Our online and hybrid study models combine in-person learning with digital tools, ensuring a dynamic academic experience. The Moodle e-classroom serves as a central platform for online lectures, practical work, and seminars, while students also have access to a vast range of online library resources, including e-KURS, Scopus, and SpringerLink, supporting research and academic excellence.

Through Digital Erasmus+, students manage mobility efficiently with Online Learning Agreements (OLA), streamlining administrative processes. Inter-institutional cooperation is facilitated via the Erasmus Dashboard, enabling seamless collaboration with partner universities.

We also adopt a hybrid event format, blending in-person and virtual participation for conferences, academic discussions, and projects.

By integrating digital tools and extensive academic resources, New University fosters an innovative and globally connected learning environment.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, New University was among the first institutions in Slovenia to implement a digital learning model.

Knowledge base

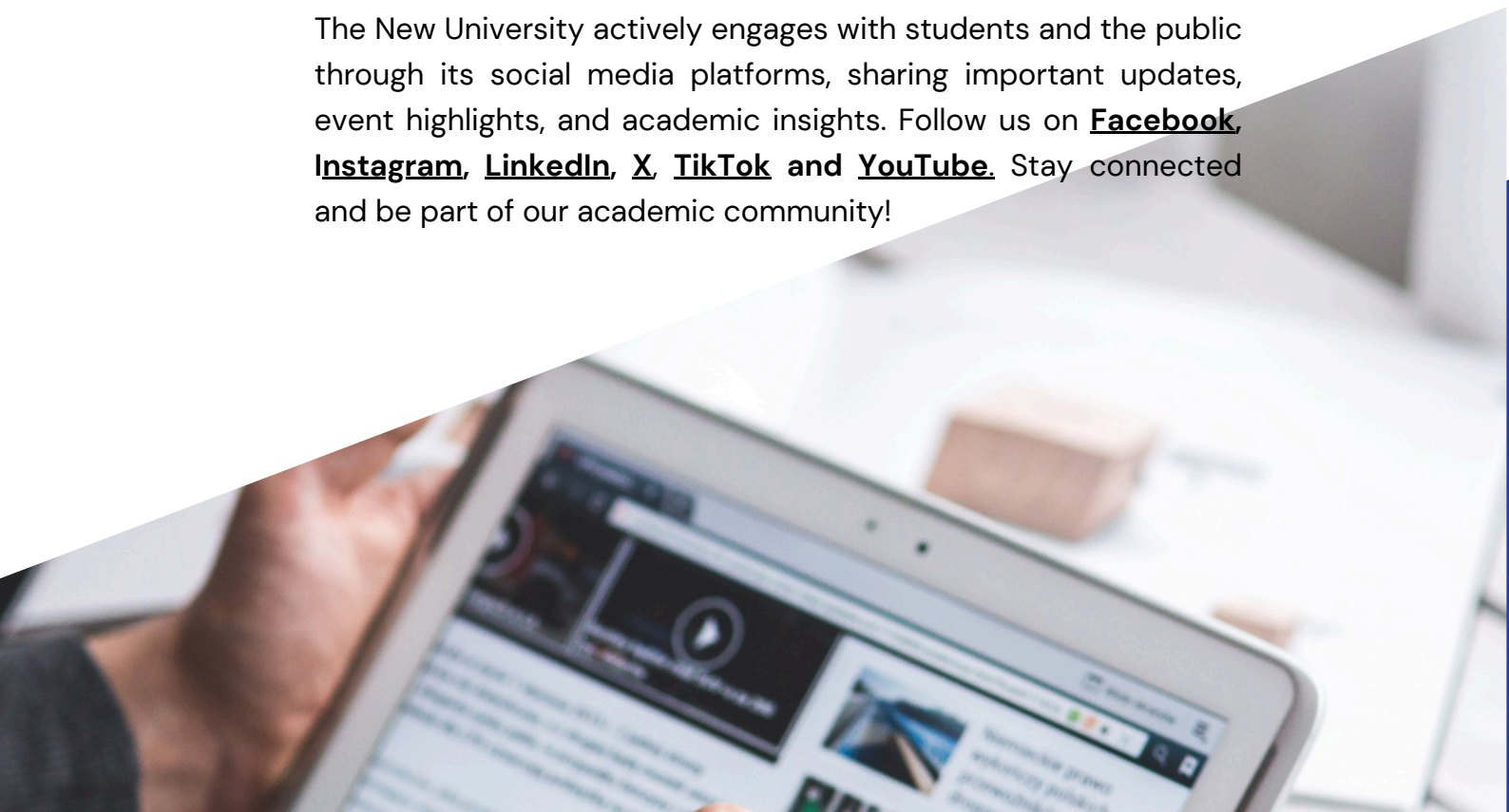

EXAM TECHNIQUES

Final exams for Erasmus+ courses accommodate diverse learning needs and are determined by the lecturer at the start of the course.

Formats of final exams may include: a) written assessments evaluating knowledge and critical thinking, b) verbal discussions to assess understanding and professional communication, c) seminar papers that focus on independent research and are often accompanied by an oral presentation and d) Take-home exams which represent a flexible, time-bound assignments for deeper analysis.

New University is also introducing mixed exam formats (e.g. combination of written, oral, and research assessments) and alternative assessment methods, including projects, presentations, or practical tasks that promote creativity and applied learning.

A special attention is given to students with special needs offering them various adjustments ensuring equal participation for all students.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

In accordance with the Slovenian Higher Education Act the academic year starts on 1 October and ends on 30 September.

The academic calendar at New University outlines important dates for students and faculty. The year is divided into fall and spring semesters, with an optional summer session. Key dates include enrollment, registration, add/drop periods, midterms, final exams, and graduation.

The university observes winter and spring breaks, along with public holidays. For the latest updates, students should check the official university website or contact the Erasmus coordinator.

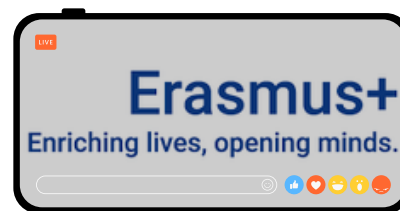
SEMESTER OVERVIEW

FIRST SEMESTER

- *Period of carrying out lectures and exercises (October - January)*
- *ERASMUS WELCOME DAY - 1. semester (October)*
- *1st examination period (January - February)*

SECOND SEMESTER

- *Period of carrying out lectures and exercises (February - May)*
- *ERASMUS WELCOME DAY - 2. semester (February)*
- *SPRING SCHOOL (5 days in May)*
- *2nd examination period (June - July)*
- *SUMMER HOLIDAYS (July - August)*
- *3rd examination period (August - September)*
- *SUMMER SCHOOL (5 days in September)*
- *New University day (End of September)*

GRADING SYSTEM



Students' learning achievements are graded according to the Slovene grading system, which is transferred in the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS).

It follows a 10-point scale, with 10 being the highest and 1 the lowest. A passing grade starts at 6, while grades 5 and below indicate failure. Some institutions also use ECTS grading, aligning with the European grading system for student mobility and recognition of qualifications.

The scale is as follows:

Slovene grading scheme	ECTS grading scheme	Description
 10 (Excellent) 91% - 100%	A (Excellent)	Outstanding performance with only minor errors.
 9 (Very Good) 81% - 90%	B (Very Good)	Above the average standard but with some errors.
 8 (Very Good) 71% - 80%	C (Good)	Generally sound work with a number of notable errors.
 7 (Good) 61% - 70%	D (Satisfactory)	Fair but with significant shortcomings.
 6 (Poor) 51% - 60%	E (Sufficient)	Performance meets the minimum criteria.
 5 (Fail) less than 51%	F (Fail)	Considerable further work is required.
